

Camp Counselor

Job Summary	Camp counselors at Jensen Woods Camp are responsible for leading children and families toward Jesus through safe and engaging camp activities. Camp counselors are responsible for a group of campers for the entirety of the week, leading them in mealtimes, devotions, challenges, worship, and fun. Camp Counselors' roles and activities typically vary each week. A Camp Counselor oversees an assigned group of campers for the entirety of the week. The counselor's group will change each week and may vary in size; if the group is mixed gender, there will be both a male and female counselor assigned to the group. Counselors at Jensen Woods Camp are expected to provide spiritual leadership to campers and lead them through a week of encountering Christ in the outdoors along with participating in daily camp-wide worship. The counselors work with other staff members to coordinate a schedule and a plan for the week and play an integral role in the success of the camping season.

General Outline of Responsibilities	 Responsibilities include: staying with campers in a treehouse each night cooking two meals per day over the campfire lead or arrange daily devotionals ensuring campers' safety at all times leading small group activities, such as team building activities and games leading campers to a deeper relationship with Christ helping campers to behave well through instruction, modeling, correction, and intervention maintaining a loving community in small groups of campers by modeling Christian love, intervening when there is conflict, and teaching skills for managing conflict

	 any other duties as assigned by management Responsibilities MAY include: teaching fishing skills leading camp-wide games or crafts boating or swimming with campers riding horses with campers leading hikes teaching campfire cooking skills monitoring activity at the swimming pond, or other activities providing basic first aid in the event of an injury encouraging, distracting and supporting homesick campers staying on site to host one or two family camp weekends
Hours	Counselors are expected to be at Jensen Woods from Sundays at 2:00pm until Fridays at 8:00pm for the month of June and most of July. Counselors are always welcome to stay at the camp on the weekends but are not required to do so except on specified "family camp" weekends. (Note: Counselors are allowed several hours of "break time" each week as arranged with the camp director.)
